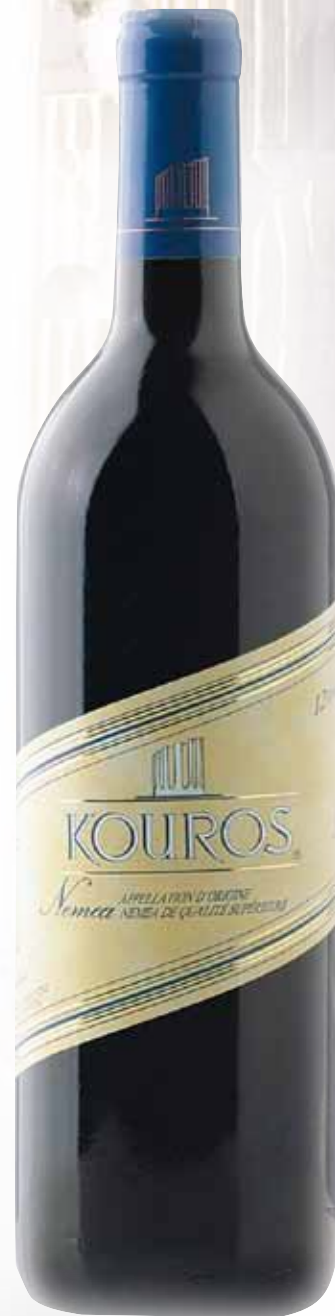
Vineyards: High, mountainous vineyards

Characteristics: The wine is characterized
by its fruitiness, its unique
body, soft tannins, and deep
red color. The wine is aged in
French oak barriques for 6-7
months and then bottle-aged
for a further six months. The
nice balance of its fruitiness
and maturation properties is
particularly appealing.

Food/Serving: Excellent with red meat and
fatty cheeses, but will also
accompany a broad selection
of main courses due to its
character. Serve at room
temperature.
